Guernsey man's warning: Babies under one hit hardest by meningitis and septicaemia.

Rob's daughter April died from meningitis in 1992 aged 7.5 months. Rob has raised thousands of pounds for MRF through fundraising events like a sponsored jailbreak, and has promoted our awareness messages tirelessly to the media.

Said Robert: "My daughter April died of meningitis in 1992 when she was just seven months old. Although it was 16 years ago, it still feels like yesterday. Babies under one are the group most at-risk from meningitis, and because they're so young they can't tell you that something's wrong with them. Parents and carers of young children need to be aware of the symptoms - get in touch with MRF, it will take a few minutes but the information you receive might save a life. That's why I am supporting Meningitis Research Foundation's Meningitis Awareness Week."
