Limb/joint/ muscle pain



Cold hands/ feet/shivering



Pale or mottled skin



Breathing fast/ breathless



Rash



Very sleepy/ vacant /difficult to wake



Confused/ delirious

Symptoms can appear in any order. Not everyone gets all symptoms.

Septicaemia can occur with or without meningitis.

Other symptoms in babies:

- Unusual grunting sounds
- Tense or bulging soft spot
- Refusing to feed
 Irritable when picked up, with a high pitched
- or moaning cry

 Stiff body with jerky movements, or floppy /lifeless

If under 3 months fever often absent.

Trust your instincts. Someone can become seriously ill quickly. Get medical help.
